Understanding ICD-10-CM Codes and the Drivers of PDPM

PDPM and Admissions – Getting it Right from the Start

Come October 1, 2019, skilled nursing facilities will be looking at resident admissions and case-mix revenue differently. It isn't a one size fits all approach anymore- rehab no longer is the focus of care and revenue. The characteristics of the resident will drive reimbursement. This means how we select residents and the choices made on admission are even more important. PDPM also brings with it a reduction in the number of payment assessments requiring us to get better information sooner to ensure we have captured the full picture of the person by the ARD.

Understanding the Section GG ADL Function Scores

We will discuss the impact of Activities of Daily Living (ADL) functional scoring on the Therapy and Nursing components of PDPM; also review examples of MDS coding for specific areas of ADL function, and discuss the differences between coding ADLs in MDS Sections G and GG. We will outline strategies for interdisciplinary team collaboration in capturing the full picture of a resident's usual ADL function, with ideas for best practice.

Nursing Documentation and PDPM: Addressing the Crossroads for Reimbursement

The Patient Driven Payment Model (PDPM) will be implemented on October 1, 2019 addressing reimbursement for Medicare beneficiaries. One of the five components of the reimbursement system is nursing. The nursing component requires that clinically skilled items are coded on the MDS assessment to be included in the calculation of the reimbursement for the beneficiaries. However, in order to code items on the MDS assessment, there must be documentation support for the items in the medical record. Medical record documentation is a key to supporting the reimbursement and the MDS in the Prospective Payment System (PPS), but will become increasingly important with PDPM which is not case-mix maximized but includes multiple components in the reimbursement. This session will review the medical record documentation that is required to support the MDS assessment items that will be included in the nursing component of the PDPM reimbursement system.
